PROGRAM OVERVIEW

- A HISTORIC PURSE, HELD TO HISTORIC INTEGRITY.

HOW IT WORKS

01 APPLY

Applications open August 1.

Submit your stallion application for consideration.

Acceptance isn't automatic: fifty slots exist, and the program is built on the quality of the sires that fill them.

Once accepted, the process moves to enrollment.

02 ENROLL

Your stallion is enrolled once the stallion contract has been signed and the annual fee is paid.

From that point, you own the slot — contingent only on your annual renewal and good standing with Fuego and the stallion contract terms.

With Fuego's approval of the sire, you can swap a new stallion into your slot prior to the start of a new breeding season, lease it to another owner, or sell the slot entirely.

03 BREED

Every foal conceived by an active, slot-holding stallion is eligible to compete in the trials for Fuego's \$5 Million Dollar Championship Day.

04 NOMINATE

Once a foal is born, annual nominations are due.

Each year's nomination keeps the foal current and on track to compete in Fuego's races.

05 RUN

Nominated offspring run in the Fuego trials for their chance to qualify for Championship Day — **and the largest total purse ever offered by a single Quarter Horse futurity.**

A PLACE AMONG THE FIFTY.

THE SLOT IS AN ASSET

No other program in Quarter Horse racing hands you an asset.

The slot holds value of its own — it can be transferred, leased, or sold — and the sire standing in it each year is your decision, subject to Fuego's approval.

DEMAND BY DESIGN

Only foals by The Fifty can run on Championship Day, which means every breeder chasing the purse is chasing an enrolled sire.

Exclusivity doesn't just fill books — it raises what every foal by your sire is worth when it sells.

EARNINGS BY OPPORTUNITY

A stallion's career is measured in progeny earnings — the first number breeders check and the one every ad leads with.

Championship Day gives enrolled sires' offspring a shot at money most stallions never run for — and it levels a field the industry has never leveled: high-fee sires dominating the sport's largest purses, compounding their progeny earnings while narrowing what every other stallion gets to run for.

Fuego's division structure gives every enrolled sire the same opportunity — purses worth chasing, against a field his offspring were priced to compete in.

MARQUEE EXPOSURE

Fuego is more than a stallion incentive with a race day attached — it's built as an industry event, marketed year-round, an experience the sport attends rather than a set of results it checks.

The trials, the sales, the season between: enrolled sires stay in front of the industry wherever it gathers, and Championship Day arrives as the culmination of it all.

FOUR FLIGHTS.

Fuego groups The Fifty into four flights by stud fee — Inferno, Caliente, Azul, Ember — and runs one futurity in four divisions on Championship Day.

WHY FLIGHTS MATTER

1 FUTURITY | 4 DIVISIONS

Championship Day runs one futurity in four divisions — one for each flight.

SET AT CONCEPTION

A foal's flight is set by its sire's fee in the year of conception. The fee can move later; the flight doesn't move with it.

HIGHEST FEE GOVERNS

A sire's flight follows the highest stud fee it advertises for the year, across all breeding methods — ICSI foals included.

ONE EXCEPTION

The flight defines a foal's field on Championship Day — with one exception: the Inferno Championship is open to the ten fastest qualifiers overall at the trials, regardless of flight. They earn the choice to stay in their own flight or run in Inferno — while Inferno flight offspring qualify only for Inferno.

FOAL ELIGIBILITY & NOMINATIONS.

CONCEPTION-YEAR RULE	A foal is eligible if it was conceived in a year its sire held an active, paid slot.
ANNUAL NOMINATIONS	Foal owners pay annual nominations — eligibility is maintained year to year, and the futurity itself is a single race.
FROZEN SEMEN PROVISION	A deceased stallion may continue to occupy a slot through frozen semen.
FROZEN EMBRYO PERMITS	All frozen embryos must have a frozen embryo permit submitted in the year of conception for future eligibility. The year the frozen embryo is implanted determines the eligibility level it can run in.
FLIGHT LOCK	The foal's flight locks at conception and never changes — even if the sire's fee moves in the years that follow.

THE NOMINATION SCHEDULE

One payment each year keeps a foal current — on time, or at the late rate once the deadline has passed.

Should unforeseen circumstances prevent Fuego's 2028 Championship Day to be held at Remington Park, the event will move to an alternate track — or all nominations and entry fees will be refunded.

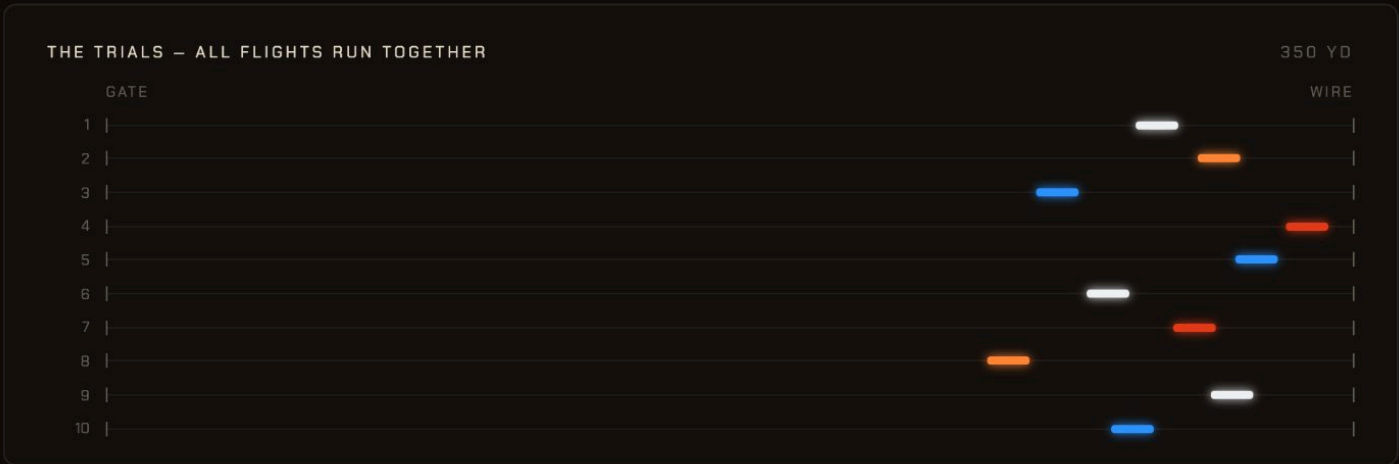

NOTE If any scheduled entry payment is missed, the horse may only enter by a Time of Entry (TOE) payment of \$100,000.

QUALIFYING: THE TRIALS

All offspring trial together regardless of flight, and the times set the fields for Championship Day.

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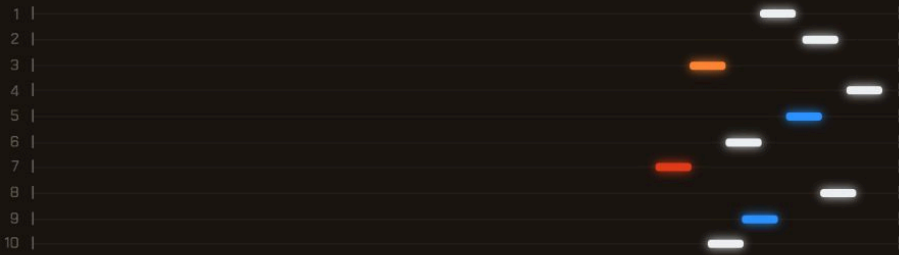


THE FUEGO FAST FORTY

350 YD



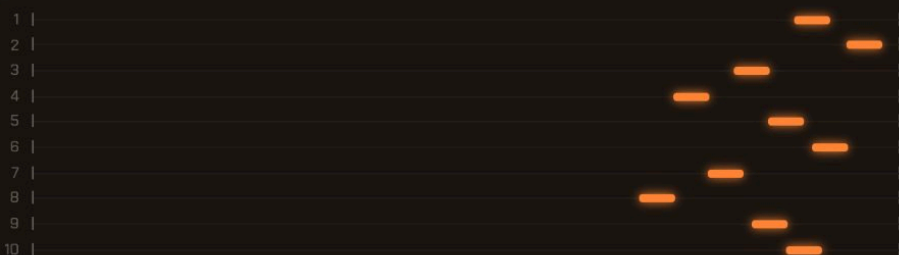

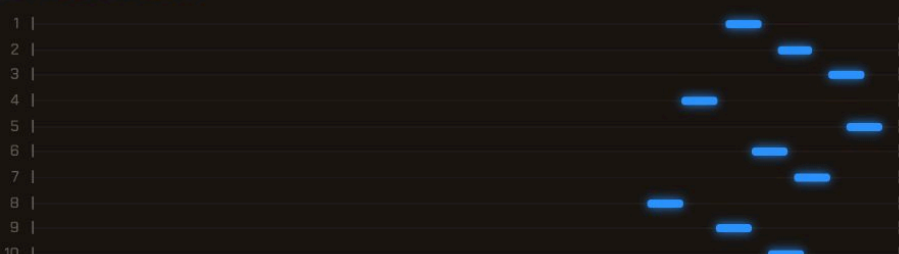

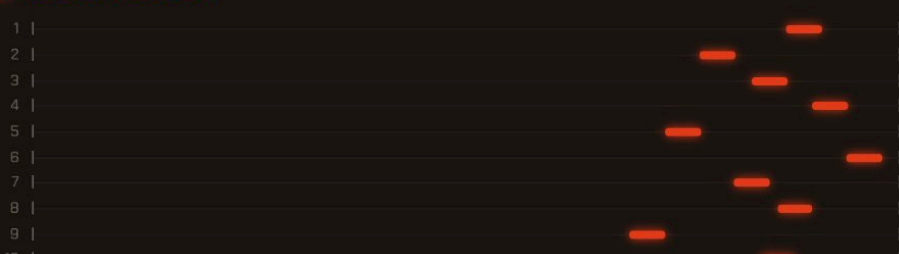

THE FINALIST BARN

Every finalist is consolidated to a single Finalist Barn ahead of Championship Day. One location, one standard — **for every horse in the field.**

02

NEW TESTING TECHNOLOGY

Fuego and its partners are investing in new integrity testing technologies, applied at a level the sport has never had.

03

WHY IT MATTERS

A purse means nothing if the result is in doubt. **Fuego's \$5 million is earned under the sport's most rigorous integrity program** — a standard built to put every result beyond question.

THE ROAD TO 2028 — AND BEYOND.

2025

First conceptions. Foals bred in 2025 are born 2026 — the runners in the first Championship Day races.

2026

Foals bred in 2026 are born 2027 and compete in 2029. For all 2025-2026 conceptions, the sire's highest advertised 2027 stud fee sets the flight and fields for the 2028 Championship Day.

2027

From 2027 forward, the fee in effect the year a foal is conceived governs its flight.

2028

Trials, then Championship Day — 2028, Remington Park. The 2026-born foals run the first Fuego Futurity across four divisions, for a guaranteed \$5 million.

2029

Trials, then Championship Day — 2029, Remington Park. The second Fuego Futurity, and the first Fuego Derby and Oaks. Purses to be announced January 2029.

2030

The third Fuego Futurity, the second Fuego Derby and Oaks, and the first Fuego Open Championship. Purses to be announced January 2030.

STALLION NOMINATOR'S SHARE OF EVERY PURSE

Any time an offspring by your stallion earns purse money on Championship Day, the stallion nominator receives 10% of that purse — on top of everything else the slot carries.

- You own the slot, contingent only on your annual renewal and good standing with Fuego and the Fuego contract terms.
- Fall short of twenty nominated foals in a year and a retention payment applies.
- Miss the annual renewal and the slot is forfeited and opens to a new stallion — there is no waitlist.

YOUR RIGHTS IN THE SLOT

SWAP

Place a different stallion in your slot in any year.

LEASE

Lease the slot to another party on your terms.

SELL

Sell the slot at a price you set.

NOTE One condition on every transfer: the incoming party must have a stallion capable of filling the slot, subject to Fuego's approval of the sire. A slot never sits empty.

ASKED & ANSWERED.

What happens if my stallion dies?

The slot can stay filled. A deceased stallion may continue to occupy its slot through frozen semen — or you may swap in another stallion.

Can I exit the program?

Yes. You own the slot — lease it to another party or sell it at a price you set. The incoming party must have a stallion capable of filling the slot, subject to Fuego's approval.

Which flight do ICSI foals run in, if the ICSI fee falls in a different flight due to a reduced price?

The same flight as every other foal by the sire — the highest stud fee the stallion advertises for the year governs all of its offspring, across all breeding methods. Example: a sire advertised at \$8,000 frozen/cooled and \$6,000 ICSI is a Caliente sire on the \$8,000 fee, so its ICSI foals run in the Caliente flight too — even though \$6,000 alone would fall in Azul.

Are offspring eligible for life?

Yes. Your foal is eligible for Fuego for life — as long as it stays nominated, current, and in good standing.

What if fewer than 20 foals are nominated?

A retention payment by the slot owner keeps the slot; terms will be published with the stallion contract.

What if I miss the annual renewal?

The slot is forfeited and opens to a new stallion. There is no waitlist — a slot never sits empty.
